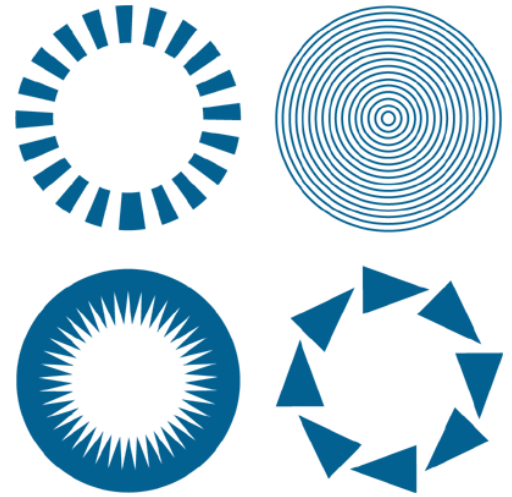

Organizational Purpose – Vision and Mission Statement

The Association of Moving Image Archivists (AMIA) is a non-profit professional association founded in 1991. It serves over 1,000 members worldwide.

AMIA vision statement:

Moving image archivists worldwide shall have the support, the protection, the education, the information, the funding, and the resources necessary to properly and effectively preserve and make accessible the world's moving image heritage for current and future generations.

AMIA mission statement:

The Association of Moving Image Archivists (AMIA) is a non-profit professional association established to advance the field of moving image archiving by fostering cooperation among individuals and organizations concerned with the acquisition, description, preservation, exhibition and use of moving image materials.

AMIA goals:

- Provide a regular means of exchanging information, ideas and assistance.
- Promote moving image archival activities, including acquisition, description, preservation, exhibition and use of moving images in all formats, through such means as meetings, workshops, publications, and direct assistance.
- Support the education and professional development of moving image archivists.
- Represent and promote the development and recognition of the profession, of technical standards, and of principles and ethical conduct.
- Take a leadership role in informing and raising public awareness of archival issues.
- Stimulate and facilitate research on archival matters affecting moving images.
